Community Builders (\$500 - \$999)

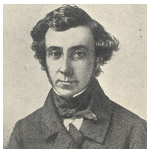

Community Leaders Guild members contribute **\$1,000 or more** annually to United Way. These individuals and families have demonstrated an unparalleled commitment to our community.

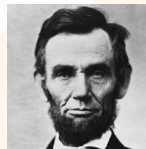
Although there is no level of recognition great enough to properly express the impact these families have, these individuals have our eternal gratitude for leading the way to a better community.

ABRAHAM LINCOLN MEMBERSHIP (\$2,500 - \$4,999)



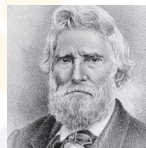

SUSAN LAWRENCE DANA MEMBERSHIP (\$7,500 - \$9,999)



Springfield heiress Susan Dana was one of the most influential women in Springfield history. A great contributor to our community, she dedicated her life to social equality and philanthropy.

ELIJAH ILES MEMBERSHIP (\$1,750 - \$2,499)



Elijah Iles was a Springfield founder, entrepreneur and our first developer. He was a constant contributor to the welfare of the community.
