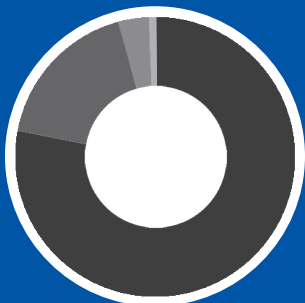
Low income youth lose two to three months in reading while their higher-income peers make slight gains

Most youth lose about two months of math skills in the summer.

By fifth grade, summer learning loss can leave low-income students 2 1/2 to 3 years behind their peers.
