City of Springfield Guidelines

The City of Springfield guidelines for Food Trucks changes from time to time. Please contact a Food Truck operator for information regarding events and city restrictions. For private events, food trucks must get approval on parking plans from the city two weeks in advance, but don't have to pay a fee. This process is completed by the food truck but can take up to 2 weeks.

Minimums

Depending on the Food Truck operator, they may require a minimum guarantee prior to reserving a truck for an event.

Donations

Food Truck operators typically offer three ways to utilize their services as a fundraiser.

- A) Percentage of Sales – The truck donates a percentage of sales back to United Way.
- B) Upcharge to Menu Items – The truck adds a flat amount to price of menu items.
- C) Optional Donation – Customers may make a donation on-site through a collection bucket.

A percentage of sales is the most effective way option.

Donation Payment

United Way recommends that your company/organization collects the donation directly from the Food Truck Operator and then submits it to United Way. This assures the donation is properly credited to your workplace campaign and assures that the donation is received.
